


Bendigo Emergency Department Junior Medical Workforce

Bendigo ED focusses on training highly competent emergency medicine clinicians in a well-developed academic training program.

Our junior doctors are exposed to a broader scope of practice than seen in most tertiary EDs. This includes procedures where there is no queue of people before you: do you know how to float a pacing wire or drain a quinsy?

We are the regional referral centre for a large part of Victoria and a regional trauma centre. We see major trauma, paediatrics (23%), O+G, and everything else in between.

There is 1 brand new hospital, 45 treatment spaces, 4 resus cubicles, 12 short stay beds, helipad, cath lab, and a lot of sick patients.
